

# Meeting with the delegation of Germany



On 21-st of February of 2018 the Institute for Strategic and Regional Studies under the President of Uzbekistan held a meeting with the German delegation headed by the Vice President of the Federal Academy for Security Policy.



The Federal Academy of Security Policy was established in 1992 and is the leading scientific and educational center of Germany for the development of strategic leadership personnel. The Academy's training programs are aimed at ensuring unified approaches and a common understanding of the security policy of civil servants, military leaders, top managers, scientists, journalists, key figures from civil society and experts from abroad.
